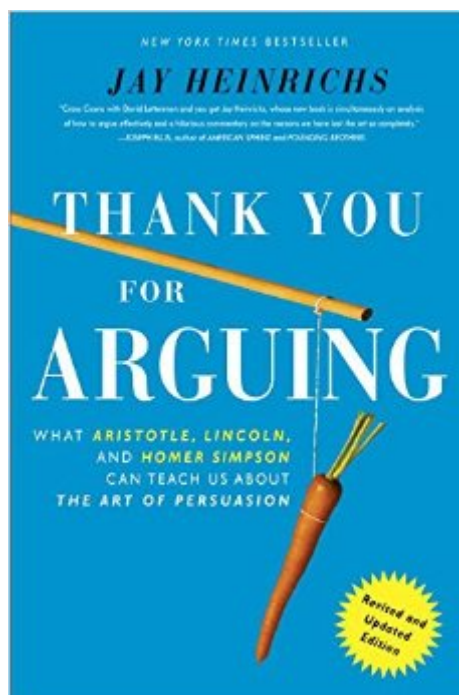

Wearing all three hats at once, let me confess: Jay Heinrichs has written the book I wished I had been able to write before him. For several years, I have recommended it constantly, to friends, to employees, to colleagues in business, and to students visiting from my alma mater. *Thank You For Arguing* is without doubt the most accessible introduction to millenia's worth of accumulated wisdom about persuasion.
