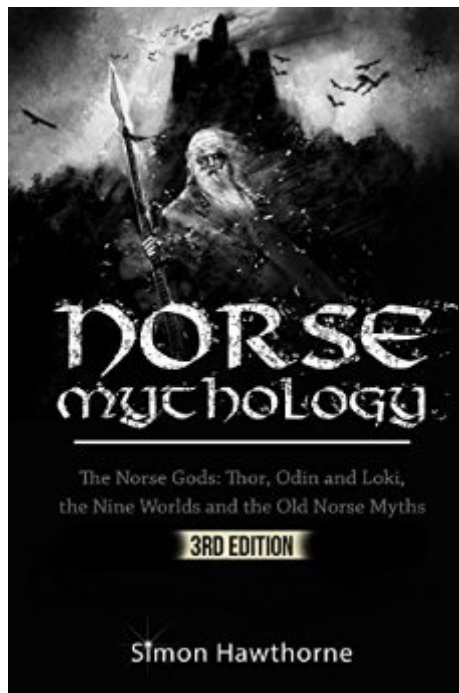

The stories are vividly written and not overly laden with academic terminology, but academic notes are posted in the back of the book if you want them. It's a very complete collection as well, with many major myths from old Scandinavia gathered together in one convenient text. Highly recommended.

I wanted to see even more of them. And that ending! It killed me! I thought a little bit more could have been developed in the relationship front for the two of them. But all in all I liked the pace and I loved that it was believable. Too many times, I read a story where people fall victim to insta-love. Not here, and it was so refreshing.

Interesting Norse mythology. I've only ever read on Greek mythology which I find quite interesting. Norse mythology is new to me, but I found it as interesting to read as Greek mythology. I love the author's organization of the book, it was definitely worth reading.

Poor spelling and grammar make it read more like a blog post. Is somewhat confusing on some subjects if you don't already have knowledge of the subject, ie., refers to a god first as Villi, then as Lothur, while later explaining that they're both the same names for same god. I'll still finish it, but my money could have been better spent on a different book.

I'm really confused why this has such high reviews. The Kindle version is only about 60 pages, and it is almost word-for-word for the info on the website [...]. There were many repetitions and errors, and the "myths" chapter was particularly disappointing. For example, it would say something like "And then there's the myth of when Thor swung his hammer and killed all the warriors. In another myth..." (in other words, it never actually tells the story, just refers to the them indirectly). Prior to reading this book, I knew absolutely nothing about this topic, so I did learn at least the major characters, but it was a very cursory, top-level introduction that was riddled with errors and redundancies. On the positive side, it's easy to polish this off in an hour or two.
