

I have truly enjoyed all of the "Elmo Jenkins" books so far. They are full of characters that you get to know, and love for the most part. These stories are easy to read, fun to read and something I have trouble putting down once I start reading. *S*

I love this writer's humor. Time after time I was taken by surprise by something written in this book and laughed out loud (yes, out loud). So far I have read all "Elmo Jenkins" books and will watch for further publications by this author. Also appreciated the many times there were references to the Bible - some thoughts were comforting and some were there seemingly just for me to pay attention to. Once again, McMillian does not disappoint in his ability to take you into the shoes of and into the mind of his many colorful characters. I thoroughly enjoyed these vignettes of the supporting actors in the Elmo series.

I understand what the author is trying to do, but the 4 featured characters are often involved with one another. There are conversations recorded intact, both sides' views in one section, then they're repeated, word for word, in the section that bears the viewpoint of the other conversant, even though their point of view was included in the initial account of the conversation. Thus, I skipped over the exact recounting of the conversation. I do realize that my reading speed might account for some of my reaction to the recounting of the conversation...I do, after all, read a book in a few sittings at most, generally (as was the case here) in 2 sittings at most. If you read more slowly, you might find the recounting of the conversation helpful. If, however, you tend to finish a book in less time, the recounting of conversations might have you skimming through the recounting to find where it ends & pick up the threads again. All in all, the book does provide some great spiritual points, like its predecessors, & aside from the recounting of conversations word for word, it's an entertaining look at the characters who populate Elmo's world.

The books flow quickly and I love the characters. Moody shows as Christians we are not perfect and only through God as Grace we can be better people. Thank you for reminding me we all struggle.
